

Term Limits Update

On January 12, 2010, the San Diego County Board of Supervisors certified the petitions for the Term Limits initiative, placing it on the June 8, 2010 ballot.

Term Limits Timeline



July 2009

The Term Limits initiative kicks off and petition signature gathering begins.

November 2009

Petitions that have been gathered are submitted to the County Registrar of Voters.

December 2009

The County Registrar of Voters certifies there are enough petition signatures to qualify for the ballot.

January 2010

The San Diego County Board of Supervisors certifies the petitions and they are placed on the ballot.

June 2010

Term Limits for the San Diego County Board of Supervisors on the ballot for June 8, 2010.

A successful Term Limits initiative will show the Board of Supervisors that we have the strength and passion to impact policy on a county level. The Board of Supervisors will know that we are a united union that fights to win. A Term Limits victory gives us a strong voice at the bargaining table by making the board realize that we stand our ground and win anytime our jobs and benefits are threatened.
